- **Parent Pay**
 - You will receive information about signing up for ParentPay. Parents use this to pay for items in school, including lunches and trips. It is also the main method of communication; sending letters, messages, questionnaires etc. It is essential that all parents sign up.
- **Personal Organisers**

- 🌱 Newly designed curriculum introduced in 2020-21.
- 🌱 Bespoke to meet the needs of children in our community

Frequently Asked Questions

- Buses
 - The service is run by Stagecoach and a bus route will be sent to any parents of children who need to use this service.
- Behaviour
 - We have one school rule, which is RESPECT. At the beginning of the year, each class draws up its class charter and children are regularly reminded of the positive behaviours we expect, rather than an endless list of 'don'ts'.
- Rewards
 - Marvellous Me badges (sent home via the app), Hall of Fame, Hot Chocolate Friday (one child per class per week), Superstar certificates and House Points are some of the ways we celebrate successes.



Frequently Asked Questions

- Lunchtimes
 - We usually run a cafeteria style lunch time, providing a variety of hot and cold meals. School meals cost £2.30 per day. Please remember, Universal Free School Meals only applies to children up to Year 2. If you are eligible for Free School Meals, you will need to apply, following this link:

Frequently Asked Questions

- Attendance/Absence/Medicines
 - Please contact the office before 8:55 am, if your child is going to be absent. We have a designated absence line where you can leave a voice message: **01777 709055**
 - Please see our website for information on how we encourage good attendance.
 - If your child needs to be given a medicine in school, you will need to complete a medicine form, available from the office (which can be sent via ParentPay). We have a locked cupboard to keep medicines safely.
